**Message:** Greetings,

Given recent events in Walker, CA and Lake Tahoe, there is an increased interest in the water levels in Lake Tahoe in terms of potential to observe seiche or tsunami. The data from [https://waterdata.usgs.gov/nwis/inventory/?site\\_no=10337000&agency\\_cd=USGS](https://waterdata.usgs.gov/nwis/inventory/?site_no=10337000&agency_cd=USGS) appear to be limited to hourly data.

Are these data also available at a higher rate? We would love to have access to 1-minute data, but 6-minute data may be useful as well.

If these data are unavailable at a higher rate, is there a possibility to change this for future observations? what would be required, a new device/instrument? The telemetry infrastructure could probably suit a higher rate (?).
