

MAP EXPLANATION

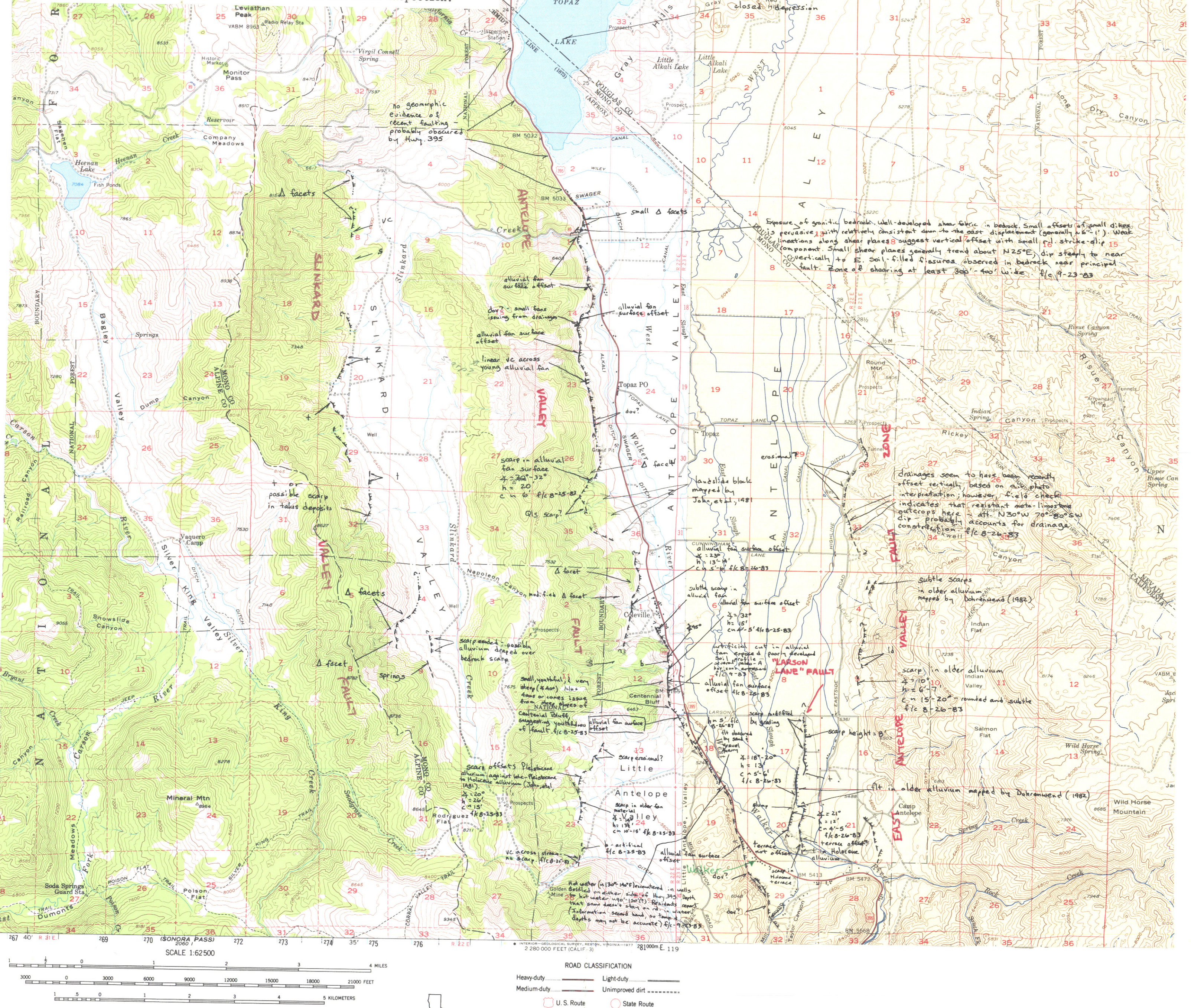
